We are grateful for your presence in this ceremony, to mark the "National Day" of Timor-Leste. Our delegation takes this opportunity to congratulate all the pavilions that have marked their "National Day", which we were told, has been done with remarkable success.

On 30th of August 1999, 16 years ago, our people courageously determined the destiny of our country with a vote, under the auspices of the United Nations. The result of that vote, known as Popular Consultation, was Timor-Leste, standing within the international community as equal, an independent and sovereign nation.

Today, in this unique World Expo "Milano 2015", we celebrate the 16th Anniversary of that referendum, the "Popular Consultation", which confirmed once and for all the determination of our people to be in charge of our own destiny.

In September 2002, Timor-Leste joined the United Nations, and became the youngest UN Member of 20th century. Our delegation cannot stress high enough how important it is, for Timor-Leste to be present and actively participating in this important global event.

Our nation came into being as a sovereign State with clear objectives about the achievement of healthy living. Our Constitution makes it clear that the objectives of the State are to ensure that our people live in peace and prosperity and guided by mutual respect in relations with all other nations.

The red is a constant reminder that not only could the ultimate goals of independence and sovereignty not have been achieved without sacrifice, but also today, the desire of our people for healthy living and long-lasting peace, demands sacrifice from each and every one of us.

The black and yellow remind us that we must continue to struggle against poverty, illiteracy and malnourishment and above all, that to be truly independent, we must strive to build a nation with well-educated and skillful people.

The white star epitomizes the commitment of our nation to strive for peace and to always work hard towards the consolidation of long lasting peace for our people and for the humanity as a whole.

It is a constant warning that no matter how harsh the road ahead of us is, there is always light at the end of the tunnel; that in our struggle to consolidate sovereignty, just like during almost a quarter of century of struggle for freedom and independence, honesty and perseverance will ensure that justice will always prevail.

These were guiding principles that led us to victory in the struggle for national liberation, a struggle of biblical proportion, where David finally defeated Goliath on August 30^{th} 1999.

We live in an age of transformation; in an interconnected world where knowledge can be easily acquired. In all our work within the community of nations, it is our solemn national commitment to strive to promote peace and prosperity for all.

In this regard, we can see that in this global activity, "Expo Milano 2015", the message is clear; that it is vital that humanity shifts its focus away from greed and towards healthier lifestyle, more integrated and, above all, with strong and sustained sense of solidarity.

Building the capacity of our people to enjoy healthy lifestyle is top on the list of our national priorities; and it will remain so for the foreseeable future. That is why we have declared eradication of poverty a national cause.
