**National holidays in 2021**

The public holidays with a fixed date and variable date for 2021, determined by the Law n.10/2005 of 10<sup>th</sup> of August, are:

- a) 1<sup>st</sup> of January – New Year’s Day (fixed date public holiday)
- b) 3<sup>rd</sup> of March – Veterans Day (fixed date public holiday)
- c) 2<sup>nd</sup> of April – Holy Friday (variable date public holiday)
- d) 1<sup>st</sup> of May – World Labour Day (fixed date public holiday)
- e) 20<sup>th</sup> of May – Restoration of Independence Day (fixed date public holiday);
- f) 13<sup>th</sup> of May – Idul Fitri (variable date public holiday);
- g) 3<sup>rd</sup> of June – Corpus Christi (variable date public holiday);
- h) 19<sup>th</sup> of July – Idul Adha (variable date public holiday);
- j) 30<sup>th</sup> of August – Popular Consultation Day (fixed date public holiday);
- j) 1<sup>st</sup> of November – All Saints Day (fixed date public holiday);
- k) 2<sup>nd</sup> of November – All Souls Day (fixed date public holiday);
- l) 12<sup>th</sup> of November – National Youth Day (fixed date public holiday);
- m) 28<sup>th</sup> of November – Proclamation of Independence Day (fixed date public holiday);
- n) 7<sup>th</sup> of December – Memorial Day (fixed date public holiday);
- o) 8<sup>th</sup> of December – Day of Our Lady of Immaculate Conception and Timor-Leste Patroness (fixed date public holiday);
- p) 25<sup>th</sup> of December – Christmas Day (fixed date public holiday).
- q) 31<sup>st</sup> of December – National Heroes Day (fixed date public holiday).

The Law n. 10/2005, of 10<sup>th</sup> of August, determines national public holidays, official commemorative dates and the granting of days-off, and has been amended by Law n. 3/2016, of 25<sup>th</sup> of May, to recognise key historical dates of the Timorese Struggle for National Liberation. **ENDS**
