GOVERNMENT RESOLUTION N 2/2021

Of 15 of January

Revokes the Government Resolution 52/2020, of December 30th, on the renewal of the imposition of a health fence in the Special Administrative Region of Oe-Cusse Ambeno

Whereas, through Government Resolution 52/2020, of December 30th, the Government has renewed the imposition of a health fence in the Special Administrative Region of Oe-Cusse Ambeno;

Whereas, in accordance with paragraph 3 of the Government Resolution 52/2020, of December 30th, the health fence imposed in the Special Administrative Region of Oe-Cusse Ambeno will expire at 11:59 pm on January 18th, 2021.

Whereas the grounds on which the imposition of the health fence in the Special Administrative Region of Oe-Cusse Ambeno have been laid off no longer exist, and it will therefore be necessary to immediately eliminate the constraints imposed on the population residing or working in that region, namely with regard to the enjoyment of their fundamental right to move freely in national territory.

The Government decides, under article 115 (1) (o) of the Constitution of the Republic and Article 4 (b) of the President of the Republic's Decree 73/2020, of December 30th, the following:

1. Revoke the Government Resolution 52/20, of December 30th, which renewed the imposition of a health fence in the Special Administrative Region of Oe-Cusse Ambeno.
2. Determine that this resolution takes effect from 00:00 a.m. on January 16th, 2021.
