Your Excellency, President of the ASEAN Inter-Parliamentary Assembly,

Members of Parliament and Secretary-General of the AIPA,

Honourable Delegates,

Ladies and Gentlemen,

It is an honour to participate in this important interface with the ASEAN Inter-Parliamentary Assembly.

Timor-Leste has been an observer at the ASEAN Inter-Parliamentary Assembly since 2018 in Singapore.

We have witnessed the Assembly encourage dialogue, cooperation, and understanding among member parliaments.

We also commend the Assembly's work in helping to harmonise and strengthen legislative frameworks to align with ASEAN standards and practices.

We have seen how the Assembly's recommendations help national parliaments translate regional priorities into national laws and policies.

The National Parliament of Timor-Leste is supporting regional agreements.

We have established an ad-hoc committee tasked with ratifying ASEAN agreements and protocols, enacting relevant legislation, monitoring the implementation of these agreements, and representing the interests of the Timorese people in regional forums.
